Sir Knights:

Thanks very much to all who provided support to the Commandery for the *Illustrious Order of the Red Cross* in August. It was well attended and the first time in several years that we've made the attempt to perform the Order in Full Form. The execution was outstanding and you should all be quite proud of the members and officers who stepped up to help grow our Commandery!

The candidates are ready to continue on to the *Order of Malta*, which will be conferred (in short form) at our next Stated Conclave on Wednesday, September 24 starting at 7:30 pm under the direction of ESK **David C. Morris, PC**. Refreshments preceding the Stated Conclave. We will be opening the Conclave in short form, as we have done in the past, to leave plenty of time for the Order conferral. We are also solidifying plans to hold the *Chamber of Reflection* and Full Form *Order of the Temple* on Saturday, November 1, 2008 starting at 9:00 am following the Official Visit of the Grand Commander, RESK **Jeffrey G. Burcham** on October 22.

Old Dominion Commandery has a long and memorable history with the George Washington Masonic Memorial. Because of this history, the officers of Old Dominion have worked with the management of the Memorial to arrive at an equitable solution regarding fees. After making several attempts at negotiation, we have not been able to come up with a solution that is in the best interests of both parties. While it may be unfortunate that we did not come to an agreement, it may provide us with an opportunity to reach forth and embrace another Masonic body and develop a new and stronger relationship.

Much discussion has arisen in recent months about the financial stability of the Commandery. The Memorial Association has increased our rent from \$50 a month to \$210 a month in the last several years. The doubling of our rent every three years (based on current projections) would require us to continue increasing our dues consistently over the next several years in order to keep up. Additionally, we incur a \$376 charge per year for our liability insurance policy. With the possibility of additional rent increases looming on the horizon as well as decreasing membership revenue, it has become evident that we may no longer be able to support our residency in the North Lodge Room. While the Memorial has been our home for a very long time and its beauty, history and grandeur is unsurpassed, I fear (with great sadness) that tradition may unfortunately need to yield to fiscal responsibility if our Commandery is to survive.

We cannot continually raise our dues for the sheer purpose of covering the rent, so the question must now be asked: What other option remains? Annually, our expenses for rent and insurance alone are almost \$3000. Grand Commandery and Grand Encampment have increased per-capita taxation on the subordinate Commanderies from \$2270 last year to \$3375 this year. We currently have 129 members based on the information I received at the beginning of the year. Of those 129 members, I am told that only around 105 are paying members (not LMIP, Honorary, etc.) Of the \$60 we will be charging for dues this year and going forward, the Commandery only receives \$35 per member in income (per Article II of the Commandery bylaws), for a total of \$3675. Assuming that we will be getting around \$450 from the Grand Commandery for LMIP refunds, we will only be taking in just over \$4000 (not including cash infusions from the investment accounts managed by the trustees, which run between \$1500 and \$1700, based on the behavior of the stock markets). As the assessments are now \$3375 and our rent and insurance cost around \$3000 for total raw expenses of \$6375 you can see where additional expenses such as refreshments and bulletin mailings will put us severely in the red. Liquidating our investments currently in the care of our Trustees for the sole purpose of covering the rent is not an option.

To add to non-financial issues, it has been noticed that the Memorial is no longer quite as accessible as it used to be, with more limited hours, locked doors, and a recent attempt at a practice night failed one Sunday evening, due to the fact that the Memorial was completely locked down with no security guards to let us in – something which has changed in recent years since I was Master of Alexandria-Washington Lodge No. 22. One alternative proposal that has risen above the rest is that the Commandery move to the Kena Shrine facility in Fairfax. Rent has been quoted at \$75 per month and we will be covered under Kena's umbrella insurance policy, for a total annual expense of \$900. Additional benefits to being a sound financial decision, is that the Kena "Anek" facility provides easier access for senior members without the need for steps, large amounts of storage space for our Order Paraphernalia, a complete kitchen and dining facility, restrooms, and plans by the Shrine to upgrade the building with new ceiling tiles, carpet, etc. To this end, following the Order of Malta, the members present will commence final discussion and balloting on the following bylaws change for *Article I* which currently reads as follows:

The Stated Conclaves of Old Dominion Commandery No. 11 shall be held at George Washington Masonic National Memorial located at Alexandria, VA on the 4th Wednesday of each month at 7:30 pm.

To this:

The Stated Conclaves of Old Dominion Commandery No. 11 shall be held at the Kena Shrine facility located at 9001 Arlington Blvd, in Fairfax, VA on the 4th Wednesday of each month at 7:30 pm.

First reading of this change occurred at our July Stated Conclave, per the Statutes. A decision will be reached this month. Also per Statutes, a majority of the members present is required to pass the bylaws change.
